

## Permission to reproduce copyright Australian Qualifications Framework items

### 1 A QF copyright items

All Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) publications are copyright to the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Council on behalf of the Ministerial Council for Tertiary Education and Training (its predecessor or any successor).

### 2 Permission to reproduce AQF copyright items

#### 2.1 Australian Qualifications Framework First Edition July 2011

The *Australian Qualifications Framework First Edition July 2011* may be reproduced in full or part and single or multiple copies may be made without permission from the AQF Council provided:

- it is used for its intended purpose,<sup>1</sup> and
- reproductions are not sold or used for commercial gain.

During the implementation period for the revised AQF, 1 July 2011 – 31 December 2013, the *Australian Qualifications Framework Implementation Handbook Fourth Edition 2007* may still apply in some circumstances. If so, it may be reproduced in full or part and single or multiple copies may be made without permission from the AQF Council provided:

- it is used for its intended purpose and within the context of the AQF implementation arrangements,<sup>2</sup> and
- reproductions are not sold or used for commercial gain.

#### 2.2 Australian Qualifications Framework Logo

The AQF logo may be reproduced in certain circumstances provided it meets the requirements set out in the AQF Council's *Conditions for the use of the Australian Qualifications Framework logo*. The *Conditions for the use of the Australian Qualifications Framework logo* is available on the AQF website.

#### 2.3 Any other copyright AQF item

All other copyright AQF items may only be reproduced within the provisions of copyright law.<sup>3</sup>

If reproduction falls outside of the provision of copyright law, permission to reproduce the item must be granted from the AQF Council prior to the reproduction being made.
